Turn right at Warkworth into Matakana Road where the Matakana Wine Trail begins, continuing east of Matakana Village to points off the Leigh Road, returns back to Sharp Road and the Sandspit Road area. If a winery is open by appointment, give them a ring they're usually on site and will make your visit an experience to remember.

CHARACTER

Vineyards draped across sunny north-facing hills greet you as you drive into the rustic, charming town of Matakana. As you discover the wineries, oyster farms, potteries, beaches, popular markets and so much more, you'll get to meet the friendly locals and hear all their stories. Only 40 minutes north of Auckland, Matakana is a town full of character.

With the first vineyard planted in the early 70s, now Matakana has one of the most diverse mixes of grape varieties in New Zealand. 28 different French, Italian, Spanish, even Austrian varieties, comprising 11 whites and 17 reds. While white wines like Chardonnay, Pinot Gris and Albarino show consistent excellence, the climate is also warm enough to ripen such red wine varieties as Merlot, Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon. Be sure to taste the silky Italian varieties such as Sangiovese, Dolcetto, Nebbiolo, Barbera and Montepulciano. The wines of Matakana are constantly evolving and reflect with distinction their sense of place, climate and community.

Come and meet the winegrowers and discover their passion for wine. Don't consider it simply visiting another cellar door, immerse yourself in their wine world. If a winery is open by appointment, give them a ring and make an appointment, ask questions and soak it all in. Matakana wines are truly boutique, and it's the people behind those delicious wines, the people who handpick the grapes themselves, that will make your visit a special one.

Their dedication to organic principles and ancient winemaking techniques led them to import a 500L terracotta amphora from Tuscany to produce a unique Sangiovese. The wines are all straight varietals including Pinot Noir, Malbec, Chambourcin and Chardonnay. Plus the ubiquitous Pinot Gris. "Hyperion reminds me of a small French winery" Bob Campbell MW.

View a traditional winemaking method involving ancient clay amphorae, which gives his wines that unique flavour.
